

Nursing Provision in Specialist Education Settings

(Emma Smith's report for SSV, shared with DfE and NHS England in November 2021)

Recommendations

- 1. An NHS commissioning framework is required for children and young people with additional and complex health needs and disabilities attending specialist education settings.
- 2. Annual nursing need assessments should be undertaken in specialist education settings to inform commissioning and workforce planning.
- 3. Consideration should be given to the legal implications of specialist education settings commissioning and providing clinical nursing care.
- 4. Delegation of nursing procedures to 'support workers' in schools should be within a robust delegation framework.
- 5. There is a need to review and clarify how the different training offers and approaches provided across the country to school staff fits with professional requirements and standards for delegation.
- 6. Ofsted and CQC should explore how delivery of clinical nursing services in specialist education settings could be incorporated into the joint local area SEND inspection framework.
